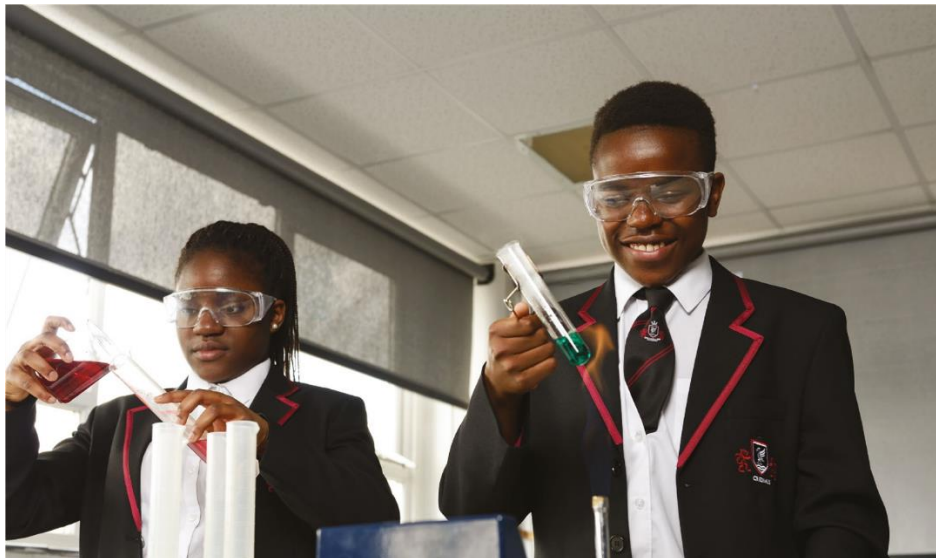


**Uniform Expectations King's
Leadership Academy Liverpool**



The basic King's day uniform consists of:

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- A King's blazer
- A King's pullover (to be worn at all times when winter dress is required)
- A King's tie in the correct House colour. Knotted correctly.
- A neat, long sleeved white shirt with a stiff collar for the tie.
- A pair of formal charcoal trousers or a knee length box pleat charcoal skirt.
- Plain black ankle length socks, or plain black knee length socks if skirt is worn. Opaque black tights are acceptable.
- Lace-up black shoes of a formal style.

The King's PE uniform consists of:

- A King's polo shirt
- A pair of plain loose black PE shorts
- Plain black sports socks
- Plain black trainers
- Plain black plastic studded boots for use on the astro-turf

Hair, jewellery and accessories:

- All hair that is long enough to be secured, must be so.
- Hair must be secured with a plain black band or hair tie. Plain black head bands are also acceptable.
- Hair must not be shorter than a No. 3 on a razor or hair clipper on any part of the head, no patterns may be shaved into the hair. A No. 3 means that $\frac{3}{8}$ of an inch of hair remains.

- Hair must not be coloured an unnatural colour on any part of the head.
- Jewellery of any kind cannot be worn, including clear plastic studs, with the exception of a personal wristwatch; this should not be an Apple watch or similar digital device.
- Make-up of any kind must not be worn, this includes fake tan and false nails or nail varnish.

Frequently asked questions regarding uniform:

My daughter/son has just had their ear/s pierced. Can they wear studs/plastic studs until they have healed?

It is important that we remain consistent with the rules regarding jewellery at King's so students would not be allowed to wear a piercing of any kind. We recommend that if you are considering piercing ears this be done at a time that will leave plenty of time for healing before the school year starts, i.e. at the very start of the summer holidays.

Can my daughter wear trousers instead of a skirt?

Absolutely. Trousers are allowed to be worn by all students at King's. Trousers must remain professional and of an acceptable style. They cannot be tight or made from stretch material. They must be a charcoal grey and of a straight legged, formal style.

When does my child have to start wearing a jumper in the school year?

Students are expected to wear full uniform including jumpers when winter dress is required at King's. This is usually following the first half term in October until just prior to the Easter break. However, this is subject to change dependent on the weather. Students will always be warned one week prior of the switchover to winter dress.

Do the PE trainers have to be completely black?

We understand that it can sometimes be difficult to procure completely black trainers for PE. A small percentage of colour is acceptable if necessary provided that the overriding colour is black. Black however is preferable.

Can a black skirt/pair of trousers be worn?

School uniform expectations are charcoal grey for both items. These are easily found in supermarkets and high street stores selling school clothing.

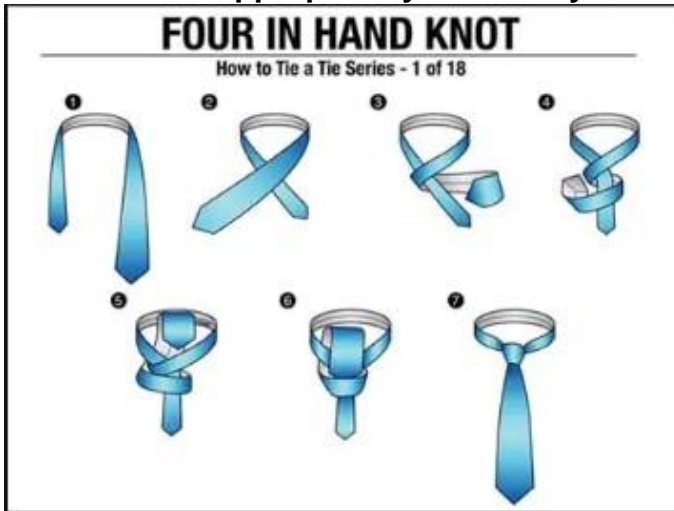
Can my child wear "Kickers" or other branded school shoes?

School uniform policy asks for plain, black lace-up shoes of a formal style. While we do allow Kickers in school they must not be overtly branded nor coloured, we also ask that all large tags be removed from the shoe. King's prefers a more formal style of shoe if possible of an oxford or brogue style for both boys and girls.

Can my child take off their blazer/jumper in the school day if they overheat? We ask that all students wear the full uniform in school. If a child wishes to take their jumper/blazer off in class, they may do so by asking permission of the class teacher. All jumpers and blazers must be back in place before the class is dismissed. If a child is wearing a short sleeved shirt, contrary to uniform policy, they will be asked to replace their blazer.

Supplementary pictures:

A tie must be appropriately and neatly tied:



Knots must be covering the top button which must be fastened and the front part of the tie must be longer than the tail.

Appropriate school shoes must be lace up and of a formal style that can be polished. Shoes that are like boots, trainers in appearance, made of suede or overly branded are not allowed. Slip-on, buckled shoes or velcro are not allowed:



School trousers:



School trousers for boys and girls must be dark charcoal 'skinny' fit, grey. They must not be pleated, legging style, jeans, cords style or any other colour nor can they be worn rolled at the bottom.

School skirt:



Skirts for both boys and girls must be knee length and a pencil skirt style.

They must stretch.

They must be black, pencil or tight, or any other dark colour.
