Dear Parents,

As we reach the end of another eventful year, I thought I would write to thank you for all of your support. As a school community, we have had many challenges, the vast majority of which have been created by the necessary COVID protocols and isolations which we have had to impose to keep everyone safe. In September, the guidance from the Department of Education has changed and certain aspects of school life will be reverting back to normal.

One of the challenges we face is the COVID testing of pupils in the first few weeks. Testing will be available for all pupils where **parental consent has been agreed**. This means we will have to phase the return of pupils to facilitate this. Below is a table detailing when the different year groups will be asked to return to school.

Year 11 will only be asked to come in for COVID tests on Friday from 11.30 am onward. After the results of their test they will be returning home. They will not be expected to wear uniform.

We have also made some changes to the school day. We have extended the school lunch break by 10 minutes and we have invested in the parent pay system. This is to cope with the increasing number of pupils on roll. These times are listed below:
